(1/30/82) Pat married since then, and she is going to another church somewhere. (3/18/82) secretary of a church in a different town seems to know Pat and her husband fairly well, though they go to a church in a different town. (3/24/82) no one home. (3/31/82) no one home. (4/8/82) - sending. She thanked me. She had round about questions to see how some were doing here. Her mother still lives here, as well.

(1/30/82) Dottie didn't receive it, & she was on the education commission. (3/31/82) Dottie reads Scripture a lot. She instructs 3 kids; she said one of the church booklets has the 1st & 2nd Commandments right in the beginning. She went to the renewal

program, which 5 other (of the same denomination) churches are participating in at her church. She has arthritis in the knees & stays home a lot. She doesn't practice the greatest Commandment. I said she should & gave her examples of it, particularly isometrics & some on the mind. We said a Prayer afterward.

(1/30/82) Jim of the laity commission didn't remember. He helped me with names. (4/8/82) Jim was apathetic. 'Hasn't started, & I tried to motivate him. He said his wife read it & passed it on to her friends, which I later said, "I hope you thank her for me".

(1/30/82) Jo Ann didn't see the greatest Commandment letter. She gave me some names and seemed helpful & interested. (2/5/82) sending letter to Jo Ann. (3/31/82) Jo Ann hasn't practiced it. She helped me with names.

Claire is a widow, whose husband was a lawyer; she was on the worship commission. (2/19/82) Claire said she passed her material from the worship commission to Larry, who came on and is now chairman. She socially encouraged me. She doesn't remember it. (2/20/82) 'sent her a copy. (4/8/82) Claire said she enjoyed it & said it would help her. She hadn't started it yet, & then I gave her information on how to start it.

2/19/82 Gertrude of the laity commission was out to eat and

(3/6/82, 9:30 A.M.) Virginia said she'd read & maybe pass on; I said, "Practice it first". Sending in the mail today. I explained why I sent it. At end, timing was not right for Prayer. (4/8/82) Virginia had to catch a bus in 5 minutes & cannot talk to me today. (5/6/82) Virginia said, "I don't have time to talk to you, but thanks". [Click]

(3/6/82) Ed is out of town until March 18<sup>th</sup> (probably talked to his daughter). I explained to her what I do with the greatest Commandment, how I call, & send things out the day after [with this church]. (3/18/82) Ed said he'd read it, & I said see if he can apply it. His wife is on a church committee, and I said she can scan it when he's through; he indicated she might do something with it. He was on vacation in Brazil, & he told me how beautiful it was & mentioned 3 cities. He said they went to see the foreign exchange student they had living with them. Sending. (4/8/82) Ed enjoyed & is going to apply it. He knows how to Pray.

(4/8/82) Marian said she'd be happy to read it. Sending. (5/6/82) Marian read it, & her husband read it. She said she practices her religion by setting an example and does not have time to do the greatest Commandment. I gave her the example of Martha and Mary with **Jesus**, when Martha was cleaning the house. Marian said Mary

would have let people starve. She said it was too extreme. I said I left much out and could have written dozens of pages instead of 6. I said you cannot have too much **Jesus**. I indicated that the greatest Commandment is the most important thing a person has to do. She tried to indicate that the second most important Commandment is the same as the greatest Commandment; and, I indicated that it was not. She said she doesn't sit around with a Bible in her hand all the time; I said I didn't either. She said in this country people can practice "religion" the way they want to. I said in other countries people cannot do what we do. I said that people in Japan and India practice religion, but I indicated that people who practice Christianity have an Experience With **God**. She indicated to me that if everyone did What **God** Wanted, it would be a pretty dull world. I said **Jesus** may not be people's king now, but **He** Will Be when we die, and we will have to Answer To **Him**. She said what she does is private. I said that **Jesus** said that you don't put your Light under a bushel basket. I said I laid myself open in the personal information I wrote, and I thought it would help. I gave her the parable of the sower, that **Jesus** Gave us. Where people are glad to receive the Truth, but Satan comes along and snatches it away. Where people receive it, but it does not go

deep enough and blows away. Where people receive it in fertile soil and grows well but is choked out and dies by the activities of our urban life.

(4/8/82) Charles was somewhat agitating and questioning. He did not know what the greatest Commandment was and didn't seem to care. Sending. (5/6/82) he said he read it, and what turns one man on, may not turn another on! I said what we have here is an Experience With **God**. No one can enjoy a filet mignon unless they try. I told him to write on a piece of paper or shirt cardboard the greatest Commandment, and if he sees it for only a split second/day, it will help him do it in a few days or a few weeks.

#### The Sixth Church in my Hometown

(6/13/79) the senior pastor said he practices it (has been) by communicating With **God** (I pointed out to him, after his explanation, about strength Loving **God** & more) [he may and may not practice it]. He has not taken it to the church council, & the reason is vague. The junior pastor is on vacation until after the 1<sup>st</sup> week in July. Forgot to ask him about the ministerium. 'Called back, & he said that his deacon goes (I let go). The senior pastor said he has not been able to go to the ministerium recently, because he has another meeting at the time. He said it is closed to the public. I was asked to, attended, & contributed to the adjacent city's larger minisitrium in 1985.

(6/13/79) Bob (the "sleeper") said he hadn't heard about it. He's going to read it, and let **The Lord** Tell him What To do with it, before he tells me how many copies to make up for the Prayer Meeting or constructive criticism. Bob joined this church. (Summer, 1979) information was passed from Bob to the Charismatic Prayer Meeting presider, Charles, over one week before I came to the Prayer Meeting possibly because of Bob's inner needs, self-justifying future, and his Prayer. Charles brought it to the Charismatic Prayer Meeting, and they involved themselves in it. I, uninformed and unannounced, came in and saw them practicing (and trying to practice) the greatest Commandment; there was a Singing group there that had just finished being on the 700 Club and were headed to Texas, and I gave them the greatest Commandment letter; by this, the information in the letter went national! The one (senior) church pastor, who rejected the greatest Commandment letter to his church and disappointed me, had the opposite effect on a larger scale, for it was from his church where the greatest Commandment was talked more about nationally on radio and television.

(11/4/80) a pastor, whom I did not know led the service, which involved Scriptures on the greatest Commandment; then, the earlier

junior pastor came out & gave a sermon on money to the church with only a hint of the greatest Commandment & then left.

(8/21/81) a new pastor had a moment of silent Prayer (instead of a sermon) over the greatest Commandment (Matthew) and Ruth.

#### The Seventh Church in my Hometown

(6/13/79) the pastor will be at a State or national meeting until Friday. (3/6/82) no one home. (3/18/82) I had to refresh his memory, by basically just going through the letter. He said it is not new to him and that he preaches it in his sermons. I went into what the pastor of the first church said about preaching the greatest Commandment in each sermon, of which he did not when I attended later! I, also, said I left that church for 2 reasons; what & why (briefly) I have done in going to the churches (& included the mustard seed in comparison to the Kingdom of Heaven, Sowing & someone else Reaps, and that what is Reaped is more than what was Sown); that I was offered a high position in the first church & turned it down for 2 reasons, one of them Scripturally. I said that the "pastor" of the

first church did not have an experience with **God** [by his own admission]. I did not have much love in my voice when I talked of the "pastor" of the first church. He is expecting an important call from a former student of his (long distance). I asked him when to call back today; and, he said he's going to be tied-up, particularly, with getting a radio broadcast started [his attendance low]. They've bought time & is expensive, for 15 minutes a shot for 13 times, he's got 4 of the tapes completed. He said the station covers from Canada to Florida with its wattage. He mentioned how he's on the run; &, I told him I'd try to reach him later. (3/24/82) 'didn't reach him. (3/26/82) the pastor doesn't believe that a person should reach out to **God** [no -- the sinner's Prayer proves otherwise]. He said the reason he didn't post it was, because of this reason; he said vaguely that man reaching out to **God** is not in correlation with his dogma. →Psalm 109:21 shows that his dogma is a lie.← I said if this is true, then the Prayers that the Apostles made and that intercessory Prayer were and are non-existent, which I know otherwise. He said he doesn't practice it, and that the greatest Commandment is loving **God** with the entire being [my earlier words to him]. I told him that not only have I Loved **God** with my entire being, after completing a cycle of

Praise ye **The Lord**. I will Praise **The Lord** with my whole heart, in the assembly of the upright, and in the congregation.

The Fear of **The Lord** is the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do **His** Commandments: **His** Praise endureth for ever.

Psalm 111:1,10

combining completed parts of my being in Loving **God**, that I, also, have Loved **God** with all of my entire being, afterward, as well. He said he doesn't believe man should love **God** in the physical sense. [Is he trying to pervert actually Loving **God** for his point? **The Prince Of Peace** said we will be as angels in heaven with no sex (Matthew 22:30, Mark 12:25, and Luke 20:36), and neither will it be needed for testing or regeneration; however, **The Prince Of Peace** did command us to Love **God** with all of our strength.] I said if the greatest Commandment is Loving **God** with the entire being, alone, **Jesus** would have said so, instead of with the value of all of the different parts of our being. I told him I can send a copy of that letter to every member of the church, and then he became panicky! He said he's the pastor of the church, and he used to be a different denomination. He said, "I'm a free man". He said he's been a pastor for 40 years. I said I didn't start practicing the greatest Commandment until 1977. I told him of my experiences With **God**, which he first tried to correct but, then, knew I was telling the truth. I said he knows more about

certain areas than I do; and, I said I have more knowledge than he does in certain areas, particularly, my experiences with the greatest Commandment. [From now on use this as more leverage with the ministers.] I told him what I want him to do, instead, is Pray To **God** About the greatest Commandment, which he acknowledged he will do. [I really should have said Pray for an hour about it.] He told me about the radio broadcast and, then, acted proud about it. We said a Prayer. Then, he thanked me.

(6/13/79) the "sleeper" said it is OK to send to him & his wife. I advocated that he try to practice it. He had to go to a town about five miles away. He said in the beginning, "Haven't heard a thing.", and said, "Why don't you send me a copy?". (3/26/82) the sleeper's going to a different church in an adjacent city, after going to two other churches since the seventh church in my hometown. He read it, & it's still in his house; but, he wasn't able to comment much about it, because he had to leave to help his dad with the car. (4/8/82) I told "the sleeper" about starting with putting a placard up. He even mentioned at work. I did mention what Moses said to put on the doorposts. I said that doing the greatest Commandment is the most important thing **Jesus** commanded us to do. That it helps us in our

I Love **The Lord**, because **He** Hath Heard my voice and my supplications. Psalm 116:1

Christian work. That it is not just Loving **God**: it is Loving **God** with different parts of our being, which helps us Love **God** as a whole being; it helps us with our Prayers. We said a Prayer each afterwards.

(3/6/82) Frank: no one home. (3/18/82) Frank didn't remember receiving it. When I started to give him information on it, he said he was tied up and asked me to call him at the State university, where he was past president; and, he gave me his #. When I asked when was the best time to call, he said not tomorrow because there is a break. I asked what hours, &, instead, he said, "Call the secretary at" another #, & she'll put me through. (3/24/82, Wed.) I refreshed Frank's memory. I told him, in the beginning of the six page letter to the officers in his church, how the second greatest Commandment, loving our neighbor, has been emphasized over the greatest Commandment, Loving **God**. I said that was followed by Scriptures, particularly from the Gospels on what **Jesus** told us to do in Loving **God**. I said following that were my own experiences in getting started in Loving **God** with the different parts of my being. He said he's expecting a church woman from out of town. He took my # & said he'd call me after she leaves. (3/26/82) Frank called in A.M.. It

seems we talked for about 50 minutes. He must have gotten it out of file. He talked gently with me. I didn't get much into the greatest Commandment. (Next time point out each part in Loving **God**. Other parts of the Bible state that we should Love **God**, but **Jesus** commanded us to Love **God** with different parts of our being.) He talked about Calvinism, of which one of his parents had a background in. He believes in Calvinism, and when I said I didn't believe everything in it, he wanted to know what. He said Calvin was the first one to bring out that **God** Was Omnipotent [In the Epistles, at least, it is brought out over a millennium before Calvin.], where Luther & others did not. We talked about my disagreement with predestination, but he had to be in class in 5 minutes. (3/26/82) Frank said he doesn't disagree with me; he said it is brought up quite a bit in the churches [which is the opposite of the truth]. I pointed, first, what **Jesus** said in Loving **God** with the different parts of our being instead of just Loving **God**. He now knows I go to different churches. He asked if I knew they were on the air: I said I heard it, and it was fine. He said he'd call back.

(3/6/82) Gene read it and filed it away in a briefcase. I went on for over 5 minutes, explaining to him how to do the greatest

I am a stranger in the earth: hide not **Thy** Commandments from me. (3/6/82) Mr. Taylor said he must have thrown it away, of which I responded firmly but gently to, which he kind of took as an insult, particularly his responsibility. He first said he didn't remember; but, later he confirmed he read it. I told him what happened to the greatest Commandment after sending it out, particularly with the competing city church, & it going national at a Prayer Meeting. I said a Prayer at the end, but he wouldn't. He thanked me. Then, he seemed irked, somehow proudly. Earlier I went through procedure on how to do the greatest Commandment, which was out of place with this guy from his initial response & my timing & feeling off. I went into a prophet and, of course, **Jesus**, not being accepted in the home town; &, I used the latter to slightly let him off the hook. I don't know

#### The Eighth Church in my Hometown

(6/13/79) the pastor is out of town, says the secretary of the church. She said he's going to be tied up for the next week & ½ to 2 weeks. She is going to get his approval. [I will call back in 2 weeks.] She said she'll call after his approval (& maybe his disapproval), which I requested her to do. (6/27/79, Wed., about 10:30 A.M.) the secretary from the church called and said that the pastor was going
